SURVEY REPORT CARD

- ◆ LEARNigeria is a citizen-led assessment and advocacy programme that assesses children, aged 5 – 15, on foundational literacy and numeracy skills based on the Nigerian curriculum.
- ◆ It is designed to generate empirical data that can inform and inspire targeted interventions.

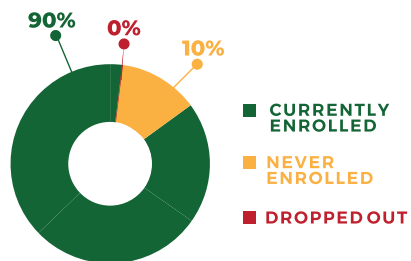
- ◆ The highest level in the assessment corresponds to the learning outcomes benchmark of **Grade Two/Primary Two** (the second year of formal education) according to the Nigerian curriculum.
- ◆ Over **49,000** children from **21,600** households participated in the LEARNigeria assessment programme.

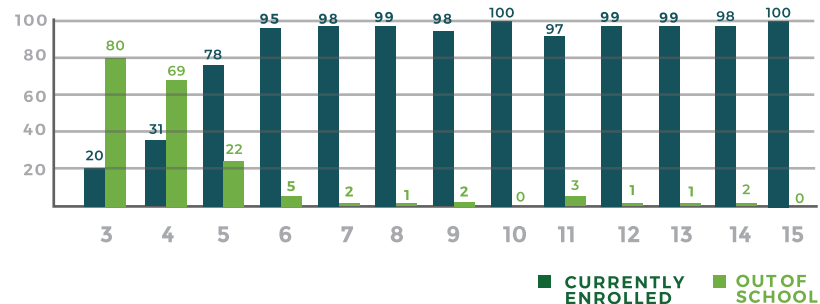

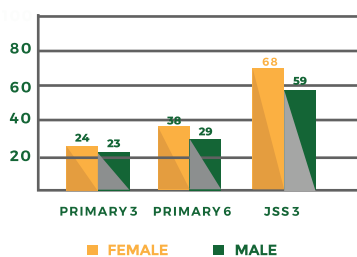

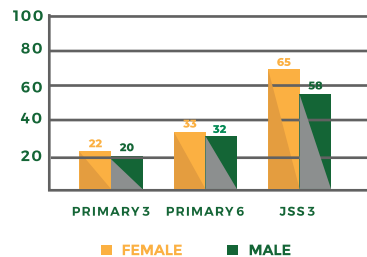

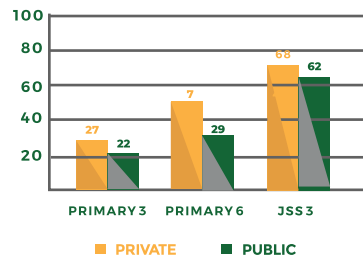
Learning Outcomes in Basic English Literacy by Key Grade & Gender: Akwa Ibom



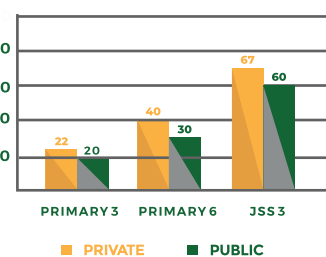
Learning Outcomes in Basic Numeracy by Key Grade & Gender: Akwa Ibom



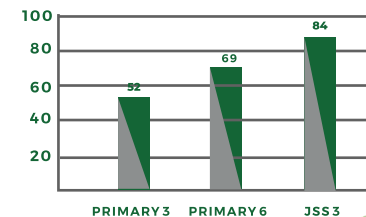
Learning Outcomes in Basic English Literacy by Key Grade & School Type: Akwa Ibom

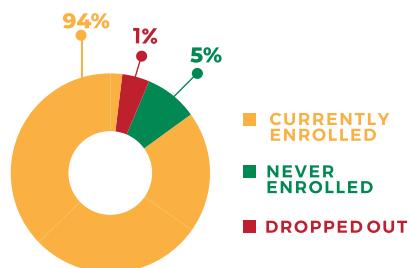

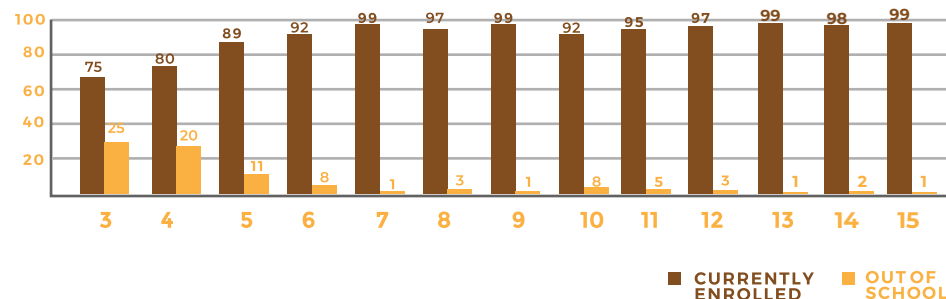

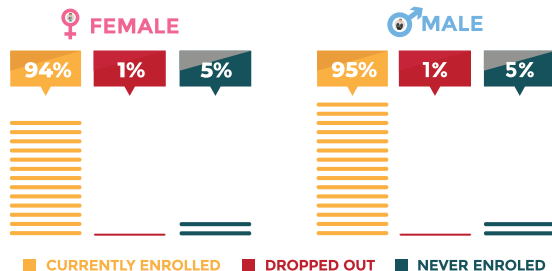

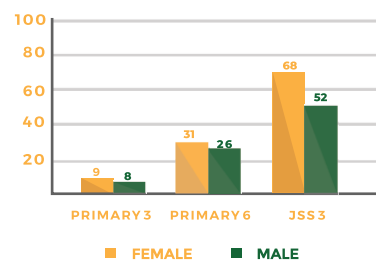
ENROLMENT STATUS BY GENDER: EBONYI

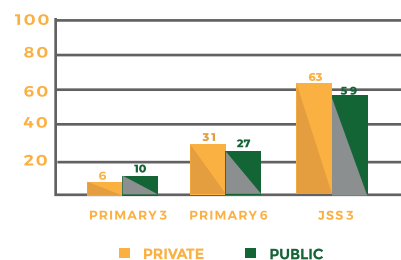

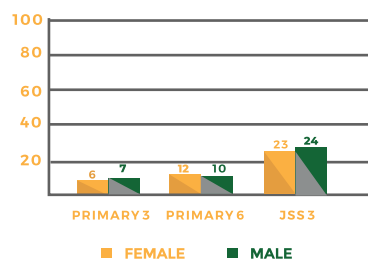
Learning Outcomes in Basic English Literacy by Key Grade & Gender: Ebonyi



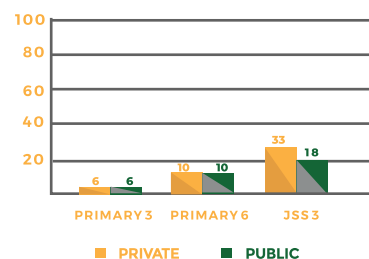
Learning Outcomes in Basic English Literacy \ by Key Grade & School Type: Ebonyi



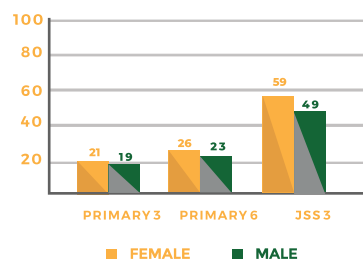
Learning Outcomes in Basic Igbo Literacy by Key Grade & Gender: Ebonyi



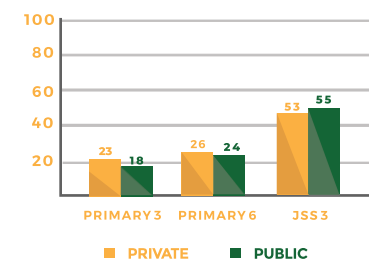

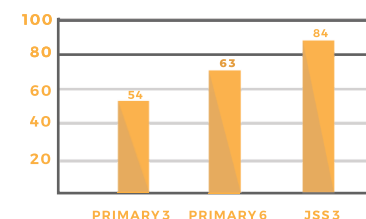

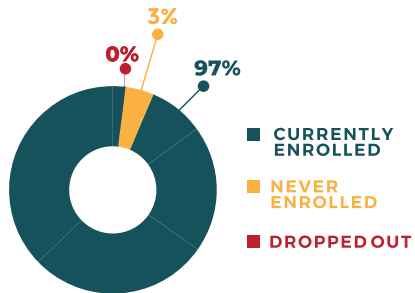

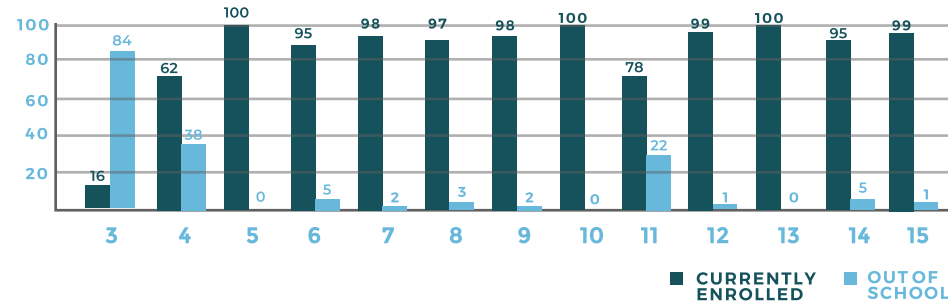

Enrolment Status (All): Lagos

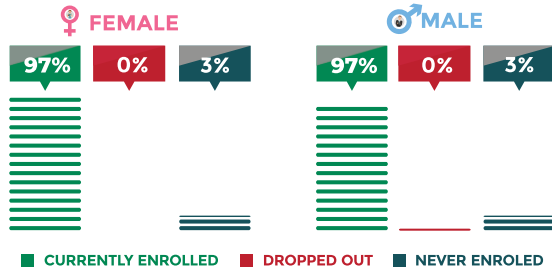


Enrolment Status by Age: Lagos



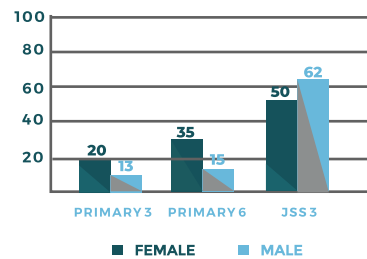

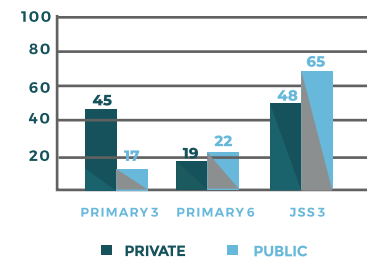

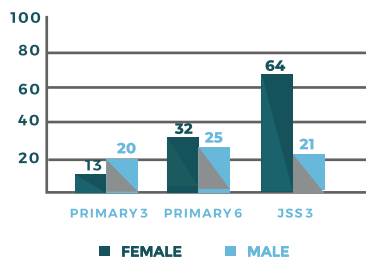
Learning Outcome in Basic English Literacy by Key Grade & Gender: Lagos



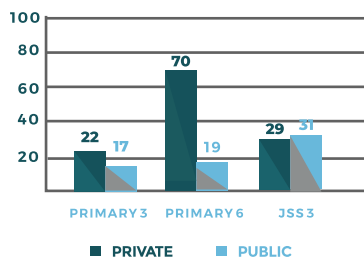
Learning Outcomes in Basic English Literacy by Key Grade & School Type: Lagos



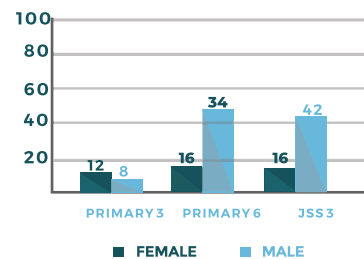
Learning Outcomes in Basic Yoruba Literacy by Key Grade & Gender: Lagos



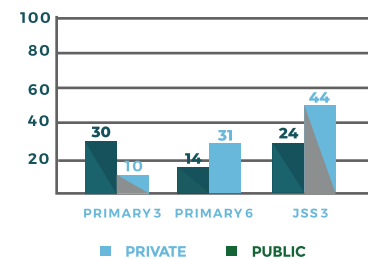

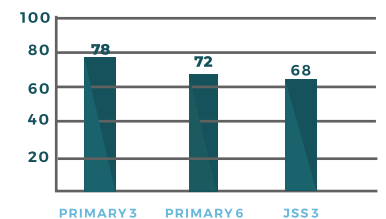

Enrolment Status (All): Kano

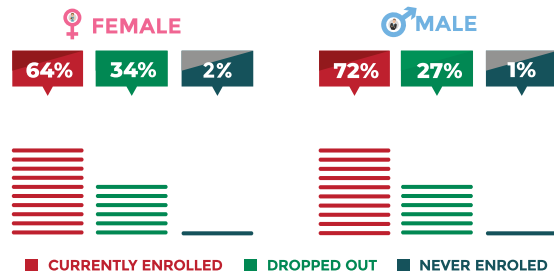


Enrolment Status by Age: Kano



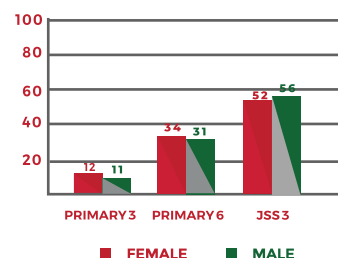

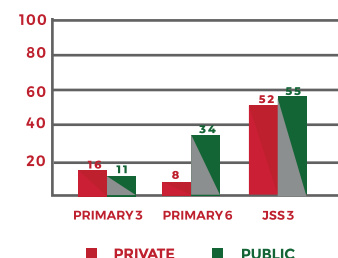

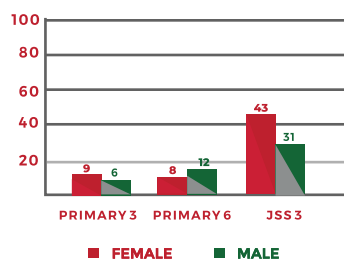

Literacy by Key Grade & Gender : Kano



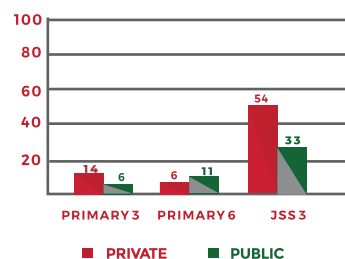
Learning Outcomes in Basic English
Literacy by Key Grade & School Type : Kano



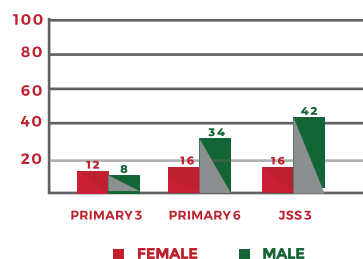

Literacy by Key Grade & Gender : Kano



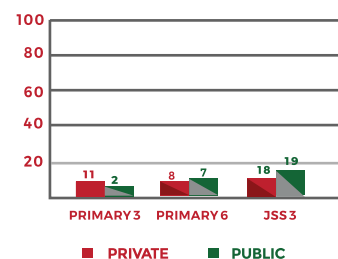

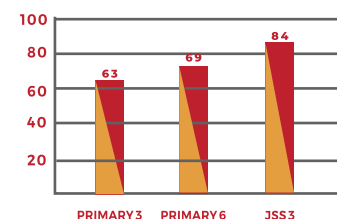

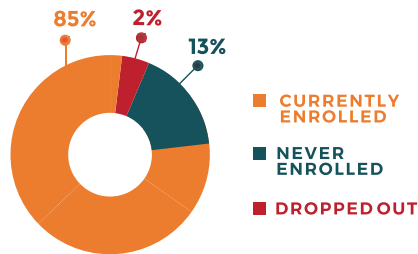

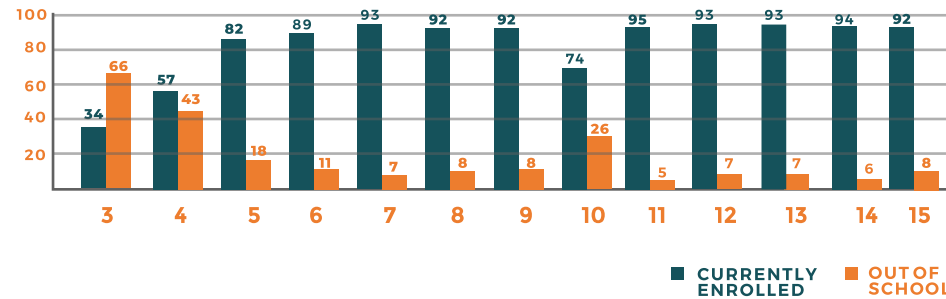

Enrolment Status (All): Plateau

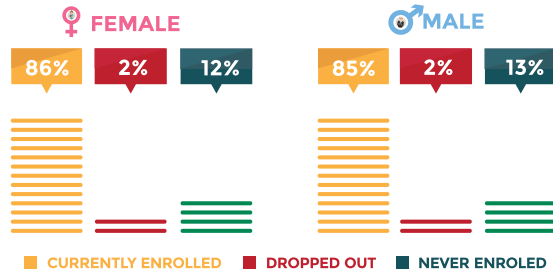


Enrolment Status by Age: Plateau



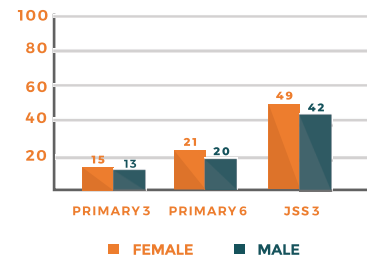
ENROLMENT STATUS BY GENDER: PLATEAU

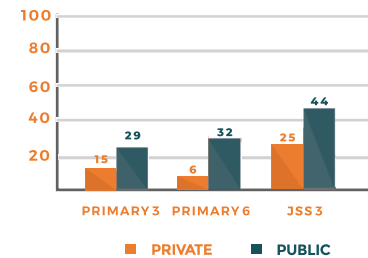

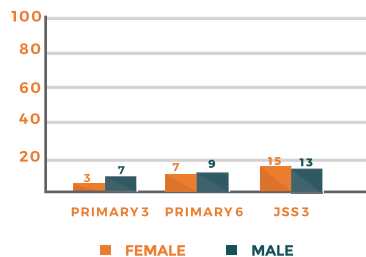

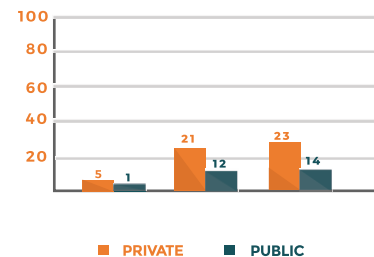
Learning Outcomes in Basic English Literacy by Key Grade & School Type: Plateau



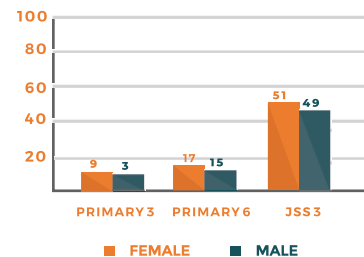
Learning Outcomes in Basic Hausa Literacy by Key Grade & Gender: Plateau



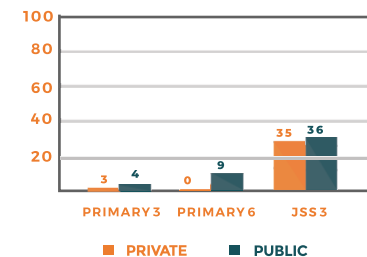

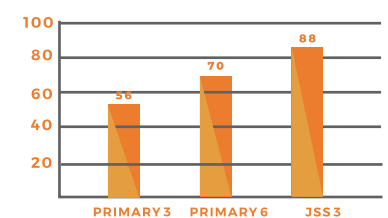

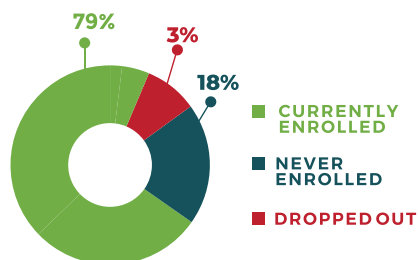

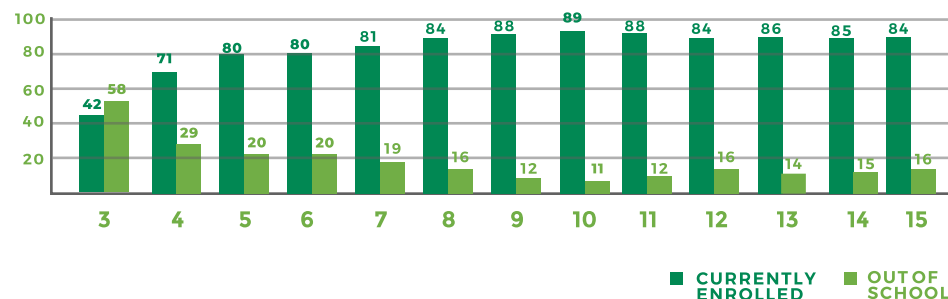

Enrolment Status (All): Taraba

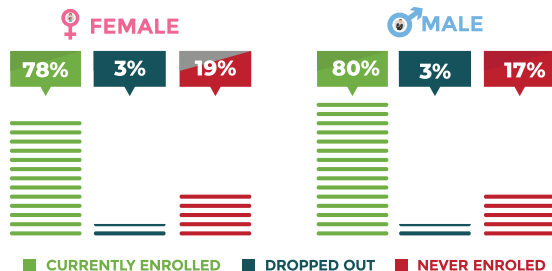


Enrolment Status by Age: Taraba



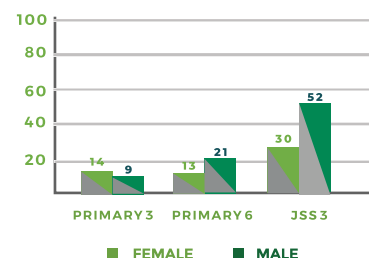
ENROLMENT STATUS BY GENDER: TARABA

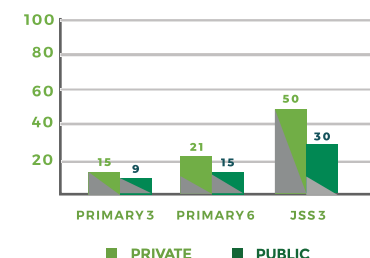

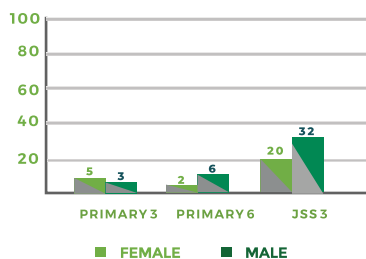

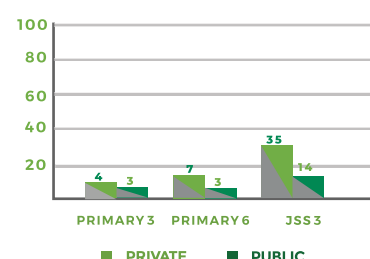
Learning Outcomes in Basic English Literacy by Key Grade & School Type : Taraba



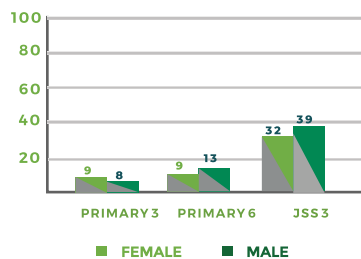
Learning Outcomes in Basic Hausa Literacy by Key Grade & Gender : Taraba



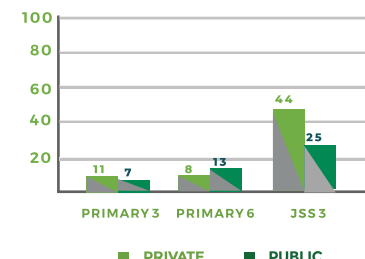

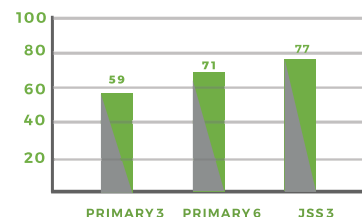
