# Introduction

Nigeria despite its rich natural and human resources has been unable to realise its best potentials, due in large part to; corruption, impunity and lack of accountability which have posed major governance challenges, stifling development and compromising the social contract between the government and its citizens.

The On Nigeria programme is targeted at promoting accountability, transparency and good governance in Nigeria by reducing retail corruption and strengthening Nigerian-led anti corruption efforts.

The Education Partnership (TEP) Centre and the Human Development Initiatives (HDI) with support from MacArthur Foundation have been commissioned to track the utilization of the Universal Basic Education (UBE) funds in Lagos State in order to improve public sector accountability and transparency.

In line with this mandate, this Lagos action plan was simplified for education stakeholders at state and community levels, to equip them with information to assess the relevance and effectiveness of UBE interventions and carry out effective course correction and advocacy.

### **Overview of the UBE Programme**

The Universal Basic Education (UBE) is a nine-year programme established by the Federal Government of Nigeria to eradicate illiteracy and ignorance by creating the foundation for skills acquisition and knowledge required for life-long learning. The UBE programme was launched in September 1999 in Sokoto State while the UBE Act was signed into law in May 2004 by President Obasanjo. The UBE programme took off effectively with the signing of the UBE Act in April 2004. However, implementation started in earnest in July 2005 with the appropriation of funds to the Universal Basic Education Commission (UBEC) and subsequent disbursements to states. The implementation of the UBE programme resides with state governments in conformity with provision(s) of the 1999 Constitution, and relevant sections of the UBE Act 2004.

#### The Main Objectives of the UBE Programme

According to the implementation guidelines released by the Federal Ministry of Education, in February 2000, the programme aims at achieving the following objectives:

- Develop in the entire citizenry, a strong consciousness for education and a strong commitment to its vigorous promotion.
- Provide free and compulsory universal basic education for every Nigerian child of school age group.
- Reduce drastically drop outs from the formal school system through improved relevance and efficiency.
- Cater for drop outs and out-of-school children/adolescents through various forms of complementary approaches to the provision and promotion of basic education.
- Ensure the acquisition of the appropriate levels of literacy, manipulative and life skills, as well as the ethical morals and civic values needed for laying the foundation for life-long learning.


#### Sources of Funding for the UBE Programme

In order to facilitate and sustain the UBE programme, the enabling law, UBE Act 2004, has provided sources of funds for the programme. Part III, Section 11 sub-section 1 of the UBE Act stipulates that: "The implementation of the Universal Basic Education shall be financed from":



#### **Guidelines for Accessing the UBE Matching Grant**

The UBE matching grant constitutes 70% of the 20% CRF. It was established to assist states in providing educational infrastructure for basic education. States are therefore required to provide counterpart funding (i.e. 50% of the required amount) to access the UBE matching grants.



## **Disbursement Summary for Lagos State**

The matching grant is meant for school infrastructural development, During the period of 2006-2018, the total sum of \$13,513,430,533,21allocated to Lagos State by the Universal Basic Education Commission, has been accessed and equally matched with the same amount putting the total expenditure on infrastructure by Lagos State SUBEB from 2005-2018 at \$21,137,529,685,62.

# **Action Plan**



It is a comprehensive document that describes in detail intervention projects and activities proposed to be implemented in Early Childhood Care Development and Education (ECCDE), primary and junior secondary schools across the state. This document usually specifies the beneficiary local government education area of intervention and schools, including description, duration of execution, quantity, unit costs and total costs of proposed project.

#### Why You Need to Know About the Action Plan

The action plan is a document that should be made public by all State Universal Education Boards (SUBEBs), for stakeholders/citizens to be better informed in order for them to assess the relevance and effectiveness of UBE interventions.
